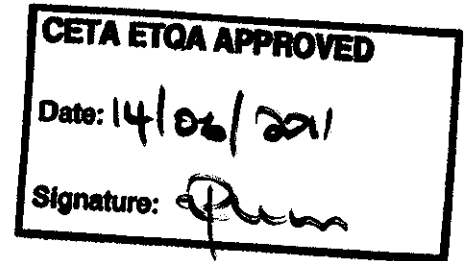

8. Allow any authorised personnel of the CETA entry to the training premises to conduct auditing and monitoring activities and to moderate internal moderation relevant to the scope of accreditation.
9. Training providers are only allowed to conduct training and assessment on CETA qualifications and unit standards for which they are accredited on by CETA
