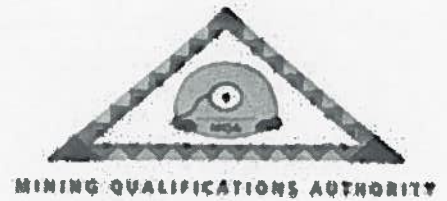

### SCOPE EXTENSION

The Mining Qualifications Authority (MQA) is a tripartite statutory body established by the Mine Health and Safety Act of 1996. In April 2000, the MQA was registered by the Minister of Labour as a Sector Education and Training Authority (SETA), in terms of the Skills Development Act of 1998.

The MQA has also been delegated quality assurance functions in terms of section 26I (2) of the Skill Development Amendment Act (SDA) 37 of 2008 and the Quality Council for Trades and Occupation (QCTO) delegation policy of 11 June 2011

The MQA through its delegated Quality Assurance functions must ensure, *inter alia*, that the Mining and Minerals Sector has accredited providers that will maintain the quality of standards, qualifications and learning provision.

An accredited provider which desires the extension of its accreditation to include standards or qualifications not considered by the Education and Training Quality Assurance (ETQA) Body by which it is accredited with, shall submit an application to that effect demonstrating its ability to meet the criteria for such extension of accreditation.

The ETQA has extended your organisation accreditation scope to include the following skills programmes which has been approved by the Mining and Minerals SGB:

- **Fitting including Machinery** :MQA/SP/0140/13
- **Electrical** :MQA/SP/0145/13

The scope is already linked to your organisation on I-Share to allow for capturing of learner achievement.

The ETQA will at the next audit cycle conduct a verification of compliance audit to re-confirm that the Training Provider manages and administers the programme in terms of the Training Providers Code of Conduct and MQA ETQA criteria.
