FULL ACCREDITATION – METALS MINING TRAINING INTERVENTION (MMTI)

The Mining Qualifications Authority (MQA) is a tripartite statutory body established by the Mine Health and Safety Act of 1996. In April 2000, the MQA was registered by the Minister of Labour as a Sector Education and Training Authority (SETA), in terms of the Skills Development Act of 1998.

As an Education and Training Quality Assurer (ETQA) in terms of the South African Qualifications Authority Act (SAQA) of 1995, the MQA must ensure, *inter alia*, that the Mining and Minerals Sector has accredited providers that will maintain the quality of standards, qualifications and learning provision.


