<p>Introduction: Confined spaces refer to enclosed or partially enclosed space, which is at atmospheric pressure during occupancy and is not intended or designed primarily as a place of work</p> <p>Confined spaces may include but are not limited to spaces that have – restricted means of entry and exit, an atmosphere which contains potentially harmful levels of contaminant, an unsafe oxygen level and the possibility of engulfment under certain conditions.</p>	<p>Minimum of 10 learners, Maximum of 15 learners per course</p>
